Some Changes in 2011:

You will notice a few changes in the coming season...

Fees: Firstly, we have changed our membership fees – they have been reduced! However, reduced prices are only available **until 31st of March** – after this, fees will increase by \$15 per player. So it pays to register early.

Grading: At the last the NCFC AGM (Dec. 2010), it was agreed that the Club should start grading players in an attempt to put players into teams with similar abilities and to give every player an opportunity to perform at their best. However, grading of players will only apply where we have enough players to form more than one team in an age-group AND where there are at least two divisions in that age-group. The Club will continue to give preference to their returning players over new players to the Club.

As this is the first year that the Club will be grading players, please be patient as we work through this process, and note that some players may be required to attend pre-season grading sessions.

U7 & U8 Teams: For our youngest players, a different process has been applied in the last few years - in line with QCSA (Queensland Christian Soccer Association) requirements. Players are assigned to teams based on their age and previous experience playing soccer as follows:

U7 Div C – players who are turning 5 or 6

U7 Div B – players who are turning 7 and who have not played previously

U7 Div A – players who are turning 7 and who have played previously

U8 Div B – players who are turning 8 and who have not played previously

U8 Div A – players turning 8 and who have played previously.

U16s Competition: Our Club is affiliated with QCSA. The QCSA has decided to no longer provide an U15s competition (mixed teams of boys and girls). They are instead introducing separate Boys & Girls U16s competitions commencing in 2011. This brings QCSA in line with what the other Associations around Australia are doing in this age-group.

We hope to have at least one U16s Girls team, and at least two U16s Boys teams. Please note that as this is an U15/16 competition, younger players can nominate to play up into the U16s competition if they have the abilities and physical development to play at this level.

Coaches and Managers:

The Club and players need you “NOW”! We already have several people who have indicated that they want to coach again in 2011. So if you are interested in coaching, or managing a team in 2011 please send an email to president@ncfc.asn.au – don't wait too long or you might miss out! This is a great way to have fun spending time with your kids and getting to know their friends, while teaching them fitness, new skills, fair-play, team spirit, determination, respect and discipline.

Coaching Clinics for beginner and experienced coaches are also available to attend throughout the year. Ask us for more details and how the Club can support you.
