A Few Reminders

1. At practices all players need to wear shin pads and boots. And unfortunately no child who is not registered with the Club can participate in training – this is a condition of our insurance.
2. There is a 20km/hr speed limit at the Darien Street grounds. Please drive SLOWLY through the grounds, as young kids have a tendency to run out on the road after stray balls.
3. Borrowing players – a player registered with a NCFC team can be ‘borrowed’ by other NCFC teams for a maximum of 4 times during the season. They can play for teams in a higher division or older age group. Players can however, only play-up a maximum of two years. For an example a player turning 11 in 2011 and in the U11 division 2 team can only be borrowed by either an U12 or U13 team, but can not play in the U11 division 3 team.
4. Junior Coaching Courses – there will a coaching courses run at Darien Street for the Junior Certificate on the 3rd and 10th of December 2011. The Club will cover costs of any coach that wishes to attend.
